



## UNITED WAY'S COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

### AGENCIES FUNDED FOR A TWO AND ONE HALF-YEAR CYCLE: (1/07-6/09)

#### Headquartered in Anne Arundel County

- **Anne Arundel County Public Schools (YAP)** - In partnership with the Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Boys and Girls Clubs, the Annapolis Police Department, Centro de Ayuda, the program addresses the needs of a growing Hispanic/Latino population at two elementary schools. Goal is to decrease the achievement gap among Latinos at Tyler Heights and Germantown elementary schools.
- **YWCA of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County (YAP)** - The Y and its partners – Anne Arundel Community College, Chrysalis House, Anne Arundel Workforce Development Corporation and the University of South Florida – are implementing a pilot program for teen mothers who participate in the Y's GED classes. The program stresses independence, self-determination and commitment.

#### Physical Presence in Anne Arundel County

- **Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Maryland (YAP)** – The program provides young people who live in high-risk communities with quality mentoring aimed at helping them succeed in school and make healthy life choices. In partnership with the Baltimore City Public Schools, the Baltimore Police Department and the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services.
- **Family & Children's Services of Central Maryland (FS)** – The program provides crisis response and ongoing counseling to victims of child abuse, domestic violence and sexual assault. The partnership includes the Rape Crisis Intervention Service of Carroll County, the Carroll County Sheriff's Department, the Westminster Police, the Anne Arundel County Department of Social Services and the Anne Arundel Sexual Assault Response Team.
- **Salvation Army, Greater Baltimore Area (BN and YAP)** – With partner Boys and Girls Clubs, the program aims to decrease rates of truancy, dropout, school violence, juvenile arrest, teen pregnancy and will work to decrease use of tobacco, alcohol and drugs. Also, Family service centers provide assistance to people needing essentials like rent, utilities and food. Includes a component for life skills training.
- **YMCA of Central Maryland (SR)** – The program provides quality childcare for low-income families.

#### Serving Anne Arundel County - Headquartered Elsewhere

- **AIDS Interfaith Residential Services (BN)** – The program assists HIV-positive homeless people and their families move to and stay in permanent housing.

- **Maryland Center for Veterans Education & Training (BN)** – The program helps homeless veterans with temporary and permanent housing, as well as job-training, substance abuse treatment, counseling and other services.
- **Maryland Committee for Children (SR)** – The program supports “Countdown to Kindergarten,” a campaign aimed at helping parents understand the importance of the early years.
- **PACT: Helping Children with Special Needs (SR)** – Along with partners the University of Maryland Center for Infant Study, Kennedy Krieger and Project ACT, the program provides training for child care providers caring for children with special needs.
- **Women’s Law Center of Maryland (FS)** - In partnership with Legal Aid Bureau, World Relief, St. Vincent de Paul, YWCA of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County and CHANA, the center implements a multi-ethnic domestic violence project.

## AGENCIES FUNDED THROUGH A 2007 DISCRETIONARY GRANT

- **Anne Arundel County CASA (FS)** – Provides volunteer training.
- **Volunteer Center for Anne Arundel County (YAP)** - Subsidizes 2007 operating costs of the Volunteer Center related to several youth programs.
- **Partners in Care (BN)** - Provides supplies and materials for handyman services to elderly and disabled adults in AA County.
- **Hospice of the Chesapeake (YAP)** – Supports child bereavement camp to help children grieving loss of a loved one.
- **Annapolis Area Ministries (BN)** - Supports utility assistance.
- **Food Link (BN)** – Supports Wholesale Produce Program.
- **HIV Aids Volunteer Enrichment Network, Inc. (BN)** - Subsidizes 2-3 adults living with HIV/AIDS in their 3-bed transitional housing program.
- **St. Mary’s ESL Program (BN)** - Offers free English language instruction to adult AA Co. residents with limited English proficiency.
- **Big Brothers & Big Sisters of Central MD (YAP)** – Offers child mentoring.
- **The ARC of Anne Arundel County (SR)** - Assists families with preschool and nursery school costs so that more children with developmental disabilities have access to educational opportunities.
